Departing June 14 for 12 days to Tanzania for the best wildlife viewing East Africa has to offer. Included is the great migration of wildebeest/zebra in the Serengeti. Elephants, lions, leopards, antelope of many varieties, baboons and monkeys, and hundreds of bird species are can be seen in Tarangire and Lake Manyara NP. See "Africa's Eden", the World Heritage Site Ngorongoro Crater home to 20,000 animals including the rare black rhino. Spectacular scenery, visits to local and Maasai villages, a delightful stop at a school, and the Heritage Cultural Center complete your safari.

Departing July 12 for 10 days is an incredible safari to one of Africa's unique habitats, the Okavango Delta in Botswana. The largest inland delta offers a variety of wildlife including elephants, Cape buffalo, hippos, antelope, and colorful birds. Wildlife viewing is from Land Cruisers, mokoro dugout canoes, power boats, and even a walk in the bush. Also included is Makgadikgadi NP with zebra herds, prowling lions and cheetahs. Optional extensions are available to Cape Town and Victoria Falls.
